

The Development and Acceleration Grants (FI-TECH) aim to support SMEs and start-ups wishing to **develop and pilot** FIWARE-powered apps/solutions in the broader **Smart Cities** area domain and **citizens' services** (e.g. solutions with a low carbon or environmental benefit, city-related tourism, logistics and last-mile deliveries, etc.)


FI-TECH Grants are dedicated to SMEs and start-ups developing new FIWARE-powered apps/solutions enhancing the life of EU citizens or developing FIWARE-powered complementary apps/solutions to existing FIWARE Smart Cities solutions that have been supported by the FIWARE Phase 3 Accelerators.



What is FIWARE?

- ✓ Goal: capture opportunities derived from the new wave of digitalisation of life and businesses
- ✓ Strategy: Build an ecosystem that will work as catalyst for capturing the opportunities. Lead standardisation in Smart Cities and IoT (Internet of Things)
- ✓ Pillars:
- Sefure: a meeting point where innovation takes place and opportunities can be incubated
- FIWARE Lob : a generic, open standard platform which serve the needs of developers in multiple domains
 - Accelerate : a program that funds developers and entrepreneurs, and ignites roll-out of the ecosystem
- FIWARE Ops: the suite of tools easing deployment and operation of FIWARE instance nodes

FI-TECH Grant

✓ Deadline: 2 May 2017 18:00pm CET

- ✓ Eligible organisations: SMEs and Start-ups (Consortiums are not eligible)
- ✓ Eligible countries
 - EU Member States & their territories
 - H2020 Associated Countries
- ✓ fC2 Total Budget: EUR 1.6 Million
- ✓ FI-TECH Budget: EUR 870,000
- ✓ Budget per FI-TECH grantees : Between EUR 40,000 and EUR 100,000

✓ FI-TECH Grant Duration: max. 18 months



FI-TECH Eligibility Criteria

- ✓ SMEs:
 - Independent
 - Less than 250 employees
 - Annual turnover ≤ €50 Million <u>OR</u> annual balance sheet total ≤ €43 Million
- ✓ Start-ups:
 - Established less than 2 years ago and/or are at prerevenue stage in their development.
- ✓ Sectors of interest:
 - IoT, Green mobility, Security & Big Data, Urban Logistics, Collaborative mobility, Smart Mobility



✓ FIWARE must be a key element of the proposal

- Provide understanding of the FIWARE Technology
- List of Generic/Specific Enablers to be used in the application
- Provide a logical architecture of the application
- List of functional/non-functional requirements of the application

✓ Required documentation

- SMEs and Start-ups: Letter of intent from University, Public entity or Industrial Partner
- SMEs:
 - Balance sheet; Profit & loss accounts
 - Staff head-account expressed in annual working units
- Start-ups:
 - Self-declaration or declaration of investment

✓ Start of evaluation period:

3 May 2017

✓ Announcement of results:

June 2017

FI-TECH Application Process

- ✓ FI-TECH call open since 1 March 2017
- ✓ Applications can only be submitted online: <u>www.f6s.com/frontiercities2</u>
- ✓ Applicants of high-quality applications will be invited to a 30minute Skype interview:
 - Pitch
 - Demonstration of FIWARE-enabled solution (MAG) or demonstration of FIWARE concepts (FI-TECH)
 - Q&A on application materials
- ✓ Successful applicants will be notified several weeks after the completion of the Skype interview
- Projects to commence in June 2017 (subject to assessment conditions) run for 18 months (FI-TECH)



FI-TECH Eligible Costs

Personnel costs

- Materials and equipment costs (hardware/ software)
- ✓ Services (web, servers, etc.)
- ✓ Travel expenses for events, conferences etc.
- Sub-contracting (only if the grantee is not able to the specific activity) (Sub-contracting of FIWARE development is not permitted)
- ✓ EUR 10,000 for the participation in fC2 events
- Deductible VAT not covered
